

A late afternoon visit to Dudley Town Centre and Fountain followed by a pub meal at the Old Glass House

The Earl of Dudley gifted to the town a magnificent drinking fountain in the heart of Dudley's market area in 1867. This Grade II* asset has been restored to its original state, as part of the town's Regeneration Programme, and won our 2016 Conservation Award.

It is now illuminated at dusk so we are starting our tour of the town's Victorian features, including churches, in late afternoon after the Saturday market has finished. We will be led by Jayne Pilkington, Senior Conservation Officer for Dudley. After an introduction with refreshments at the Old Glass House pub at 5pm (around the corner from the Market Place) we will take a circular route, finishing back again at the Old Glass House for a pub meal, at your own expense at about 7pm.
