To commemorate the 50th anniversary of the founding of the Birmingham & West Midlands Group, on the 19th January 1967, we have commissioned a Tea Towel from Countryside Art in Spilsby, Lincolnshire.

It is printed in **Victorian Society red** on 100% English unbleached cotton and features prominent Victorian buildings, including the Town Hall, Curzon Street Railway Station, St Chad's Cathedral, The Union Club, School of Art, Victoria Law Courts, Spring Hill Library and the Eagle Insurance. The centrepiece of the towel is the former Head Post Office in Birmingham, which the Society was instrumental in saving from destruction in the early 1980s.



It is available to buy at a cost of £5.00 and can be posted at an additional cost of £2.00, but is available at all of our meetings throughout 2017.
